Invoice, Bill of lading, Actual Mill Test Certificates, Insurance copy, Bill of Entry etc. shall be submitted consignment-wise. The application should also include a checklist (annexed). The covering letter of the application should also include the following consignment-wise information, and all documents should be properly flagged for reference:
