Notice

Subject: Modification of Policy Condition regarding import under all HS codes in Chapter 72, 73 and 86 of ITC (HS), 2017 to require compulsory registration under Steel Import Monitoring System (SIMS)-reg.

With a view to simplify the process of compulsory registration under Steel Import Monitoring System (SIMS) for imports of small consignments by MSMEs/ other small importers as well as imports made under Advance Authorization/ SEZ/ EOU route for export purposes, following changes have been made with regards to registration in SIMS:

- (i) A facility of generating SARAL SIMS registration, for a financial year, has been provided through a separate portal which can be accessed at https://sims.steel.gov.in/saral
- (ii) The importer can register under SARAL SIMS for
 - a. Import of small consignments (less than or equal to 10MT) subject to a cap of 1000 MT per annum ('SARAL SIMS for Small Import'), or
 - b. Import under Advance Authorization/SEZ/EOU route ('SARAL SIMS for Export Purposes')
- (iii) While generating SARAL SIMS registration, the importers have to declare only the total quantity in the portal.
- (iv) Such importers shall be required to file return of actual imports made corresponding to the SARAL SIMS registration. In case of no imports, a Nil return has to be filed. The return of the SARAL SIMS registration of the financial year shall be filed by 30th April of the next financial year.
- (v) Importer can make import against the SARAL SIMS registration, generated in a particular year, upto the 30th April of next financial year.
- (vi) Importer will be allowed to generate the SARAL SIMS registration of a financial year only after filing return of actual import made corresponding to the SARAL SIMS registration of the preceding financial year.
- (vii) SARAL SIMS for 'Small Imports':
 - a. In case an importer registered under SARAL SIMS exceeds the threshold of 1000 MT of actual import in a financial year, the importers will have to generate regular SIMS registration for subsequent imports during the financial year.
 - b. In case any importer, after availing the facility of SARAL SIMS, makes import of a consignment by generating regular SIMS, they will not be allowed to avail the facility of SARAL SIMS for the remaining period of the financial year.
 - c. For the current financial year (FY 2025-26), the importer will be allowed to generate SARAL SIMS registration for importing small quantity of less than or equal to 10 MT subject to a cap of 500 MT for the period November, 2025 to April, 2026.

- (viii) SARAL SIMS for Export Purposes: The facility for generating SARAL SIMS registration is also available for imports under 'Advance Authorization' and 'SEZ/EOU' route without any threshold, for export purposes only. In case of import for domestic clearances, importer will be required to generate regular SIMS.
- (ix) A single sign-on facility is being provided to the user wherein, the user can use the same Login Credentials for SIMS and SARAL SIMS.
- 2. This will be effective from 21.11.2025.
