GROWTH OF STEEL SECTOR IN ODISHA

(a)to(e): Steel is a deregulated sector and the Government acts as a facilitator by creating a conducive policy environment for the development of the steel sector. Decisions such as investment, capacity expansion, modernization, employment, export etc. are dependent on the market conditions and technocommercial analysis of individual companies. The details of crude steel production and crude steel capacity in Odisha during the last 5 years are as follows: -
