The application should also include a checklist (annexed).
- For applications in which the material is in transit or reached port of destination, in addition to the above, all relevant documents viz. Invoice, Bill of lading, Actual Mill Test Certificates, Insurance copy, Bill of Entry etc. shall be submitted consignment-wise. The application should also include a checklist (annexed). The covering letter of the application should also include the following consignment-wise information, and all documents should be properly flagged for reference:

- Hard copy of the application along with relevant documents duly signed, stamped and endorsed that it is a true copy of the primary document, shall reach this office one week before the date of the scheduled meeting, for consideration and examination. - If repeat cases, copy of the previous clarifications from Ministry of Steel must be submitted along with the application. The covering letter should clearly indicate in the subject that the application is for repeat case, to avoid delay in processing.
- No special requests shall be entertained.
