Subject: Constitution of Steel Consumers' Council --- regarding.

No. 5(2)/2019-SD(I)-Vide Resolution No. SC-1(1)/86-III dated 31<sup>st</sup> January, 1986, the then Ministry of Steel & Mines had constituted a Steel Consumers' Council (SCC) under the chairmanship of Minister for Steel & Mines consisting of representatives of the Government, Producers and Consumers of Iron and Steel, House Builders and related industries. The SCC is re-constituted from time to time, as and when the new Hon'ble Steel Minister assumes the charge of Minister of Steel. The functions of the SCC is to assist and advice the Government in addressing the issues of small producers and fulfilment of the needs of the domestic consumers' and redressal of issues related to demand and supply of iron and steel in the country.
