Will the Minister of STEEL be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is aware that there are many steel industries/plants in Dhenkanal and Angul districts of Odisha;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the total production thereon;
- (c) whether the local unemployed are given preference in appointment in the industries/plants;
- (d) whether the Government has solved all the problems of the displaced, if so, the details thereof;
- (e) whether all the rules of pollution are followed by these factories;
- (f) if so, the details thereof; and
- (g) if not, the measures being taken by the Government for the solution?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE (SHRI BHUPATHIRAJU SRINIVASA VARMA) MINISTRY OF STEEL

(a)to(g): Steel is a deregulated sector and decisions regarding setting up steel plants are taken by industry based on techno-commercial considerations. Steel plants are governed by local industrial, labour and environmental laws. Dhenkanal and Angul districts have 15 and 9 steel factories, respectively.
