## **EMPLOYMENT GENERATION IN STEEL INDUSTRY**

1875. DR. MANOJ RAJORIA:

Will the Minister of STEEL be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has made an assessment of the scope to increase employment opportunities in steel industry in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof including the details of employment generated through steel industry, during last three years and current year, State/UT-wise; and
- (c) the policy formulated by the Government to increase employment opportunities in steel industry?

## **ANSWER**

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR STEEL

(SHRI VISHNU DEO SAI)

- (a) Government engaged Indian Institute of Metal (IIM), Kolkata in March, 2007 for a comprehensive study on technical manpower requirement at different levels in the steel industry. The report has been submitted by IIM, Kolkata to Ministry of Steel in March, 2008 which inter-alia covers discipline-wise requirement of technical manpower needed by the iron and steel industry by the year 2020, including shortages thereof.
- (b)&(c): Steel being a deregulated sector, employment decisions are taken by the individual steel companies, hence, the details of year-wise employment generated through steel industry is not maintained in the Ministry of Steel.
