Will the Minister of STEEL be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the health centres being operated by Bhilai Steel Plant (BSP) in Chhattisgarh, location-wise;
- (b) whether any efforts being made by the Government to make the sector-9 hospital of BSP the national level super-speciality hospital by appointing specialist doctors and by increasing medical facilities;
- (c) if so, the details thereof;
- (d) whether the BSP refers their employees to Apollo hospital of Hyderabad for treatment; and
- (e) if so, the total amount paid by BSP management to Apollo hospital so far during each of the last three years and the current year?
