**SCRAP AT BOKARO STEEL PLANT**

39. DR. RAVINDRA KUMAR RAY:

Will the Minister of STEEL be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the removal of scrap from the SAIL plant of Bokaro, Jharkhand has been started and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (b) the date on which the last tender meant for this work ended;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to start the scrap removal work at the earliest keeping in view the interests of labourers engaged therein and take action against the officers responsible for delays; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

- (a) The removal of scrap in Bokaro Steel Plant (BSL) is a continuous process.
