- (c) the number of people who lost their jobs and whether Government will rehabilitate the workers?

- (a)&(b): No Plant of a CPSE under Ministry of Steel is closed. The Government had accorded 'in principle' approval for strategic disinvestment of Visveswaraya Iron & Steel Plant (VISP) in October 2016. Subsequently, due to inability expressed by the shortlisted bidders to participate further in the transaction for Strategic Disinvestment, Expression of Interest (EOI) for disinvestment has been annulled and process for closure of Visveswaraya Iron & Steel Plant, Bhadravati has been conveyed vide Office Memorandum of Department of Investment and Public Asset Management (DIPAM) dated 14/10/2022.
- (c) Does not arise in view of (a)&(b) above.
