**STATUS OF PSU STEEL PLANTS**

313. SHRI SANDEEP KUMAR PATHAK:

Will the Minister of STEEL be pleased to state:

- (a) the name of the PSU steel plants which are considered to be ailing;  
(b) steps taken by Government in the last five years for revival or disinvestment of ailing PSUs;  
(c) Government's plan for their revival or disinvestment;  
(d) the name of the PSU steel plants under consideration for disinvestment;  
(e) the year-wise, profit or loss details of each PSU steel plant for the last five years along with their liabilities; and  
(f) the PSU steel plants where there had been delay in paying the salaries of employees in the last five years, and details and reasons thereof?

(a)to(c): There are three public-sector companies manufacturing steel in the country: Steel Authority of India Ltd.(SAIL), NMDC Steel Ltd (NSL) and Rashtriya Ispat Nigam Ltd.(RINL). SAIL, NSL and RINL do not fall under the category of sick CPSEs.
