STEEL PLANT AT BAYYARAM, TELANGANA

1574. SHRI DEVENDER GOUD T.:

Will the Minister of STEEL be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that Government is going to invest ₹ 1.5 lakh crores in setting up of steel plants in 4 States;
- (b) if so, whether Ministry is setting up a steel plant at Bayyaram in Telangana; and
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF STEEL AND MINES (SHRI VISHNU DEO SAI)

(a) Steel Authority of India Limited (SAIL) has prepared a draft plan "Vision 2025" for increasing its hot metal production from a level of around 23 MTPA (after the ongoing expansion plan) to around 50 MTPA in a phased manner by 2025-26. The estimated investment in expansion of the integrated steel plants is likely to be around ₹ 1.5 lakh crore. National Mineral Development Corporation (NMDC) is constructing a 3 MTPA integrated steel plant at Nagarnar, Chhattisgarh with an investment of ₹ 15,525 crore.

(b)&(c): As per the 13th schedule of the Andhra Pradesh Reorganisation Act, 2014, SAIL is to examine the feasibility of establishing an Integrated Steel Plant in Khammam district of Telangana. The feasibility report has been prepared and submitted by SAIL.
