- (a) how many steel industries are there in the country and their production capacity especially public sector undertaking industries;
- (b) how many steel plants are running under loss and quantum of loss incurred during last three years;
- (c) the number of employees working in these industries; and
- (d) the steps taken by the Ministry to overcome from these lacunae?

(a) There are 9 steel plants in the public sector and 1321 steel plants in the private sector. The production capacity of public sector steel plants and private sector steel plants is given below:

Figures in '000 tonnes

| Sector                      | Capacity |
|-----------------------------|----------|
| Public Sector Steel Plants  | 15929    |
| Private Sector Steel Plants | 85092    |

(b)&(c): The Government does not maintain any records of the steel plants running under loss and the number of employees working in steel industries. However, no PSU is running in loss and the number of employees working in Public Sector Steel Plants is given below:

| Name of the PSU                         | No. of employees as on 1.3.2015 |
|---|---------------------------------|
| Steel Authority of India Limited (SAIL) | 93851                           |
| Rashtriya Ispat Nigam Limited (RINL)    | 18111                           |

(d) Steel being a deregulated sector, the role of the Government is limited to that of a facilitator only.
