STATUS OF BAYYARAM PROJECT IN TELANGANA

As per the 13th Schedule of the Andhra Pradesh Reorganisation Act, 2014, Steel Authority of India Limited (SAIL) was to examine the feasibility of establishing an Integrated Steel Plant in Khammam district of Telangana within 6 months from the appointed day, i.e. 02.06.2014. The feasibility report was submitted by SAIL on 01.12.2014. As per the feasibility report setting up of steel plant with the proposed configurations is prima facie not financially viable. A Task Force has been constituted to suggest ways and means to make the setting up of a steel plant in Telangana financially viable, identify and quantify incentives and concession required and prepare a road map with responsibility mapping.
