ANSWER

(a)to(d): Ministry of Steel has made efforts to invite Japanese Steel companies to invest further in India, particularly to set up high grade steel making plants. Existing Joint Ventures between Indian Private steel companies and Japanese steel companies are contributing in increase in India's per capita steel production.
